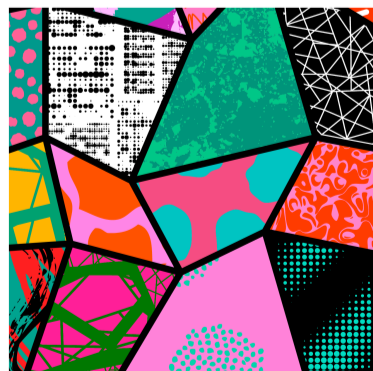

Soccer fever is taking over the **Newark Museum of Art on June 17, 2026**, as fans gather for a lively **FIFA World Cup Watch Party** cheering on Portugal in museum-style fashion. Maintained by the Montclair Foundation, this floral wonderland feels like part secret garden, part storybook setting. It's the kind of place where even the flowers seem to know they're photogenic.



Bold, layered, and beautifully thought-provoking, **The Spectrum of Resilience Exhibition** arrives at the newly renamed **Rowan University Museum of Contemporary Art (RUMOCA) from April 8-June 25, 2026**. New Jersey-born artist **Jazlyne Sabree** fills the space with richly textured collages exploring identity, ancestry, memory, and cultural resilience through the lens of the African Diaspora. Between paint, paper, found materials, and powerful storytelling, every piece feels like both an artwork and a conversation.
